Atta Rainforest Lodge and the Iwokrama Canopy Walkway are located within the Iwokrama Forest Reserve in Central Guyana. The 154m long Walkway is only a short walk from the Lodge and a series of platforms linked by suspension bridges allow visitors views across the forest canopy.
